Check List, Tanzania Study Abroad 2020



The most important things you need to take care of...

Monday, 18 May 2020: Be at Emirates check-in desk at Washington Dulles, 8:00am

Documents

- Passport
- HTH Health insurance card
- Second photo ID: PSU ID; International Student ID (if you have one)
- One photocopy of your important documents and cards, packed separately:
 - Passport (including the pages with photos and data and the one with the visa)
 - HTH Health Insurance card
 - 2nd photo ID
 - ATM card, credit card
 - Prescriptions or any important medical information

Money

- ATM card. <u>Call your bank to tell them about your travel before leaving the US</u>
- US\$150-200, in \$50 notes. <u>Must be dated 2012 or later, no tears</u>
- Credit card. Call your credit card company to tell them about your travel before leaving the US

Health

- Anti-Malaria medicine, REQUIRED. If you are taking the once-weekly, take the first on Monday, 11 May
- **Prescriptions**: Enough for the whole trip and a written prescription to identify the material (including syringes)
- Contact lenses, eye glasses: If you use contacts, bring glasses as well; if you use glasses, bring an extra pair

Packing

- One checked bag, weighing less than 70 lbs., and a daypack; see packing list; YOU MUST TRAVEL LIGHT
- Neck pouch or money belt for your official documents and money
- School supplies, see list
- British-style three-pronged plug adapters: 220V, 50Hz converter if any of your gear is 110V, 60Hz
- No TSA-illegal objects in your carry-on; check for the latest information (www.tsa.gov)
