In a browser, go to Penn State Service Now for access to the request form by using this link:

Fill out the request form and submit.

Once the request has been fulfilled, you will use your PSU account and password to release print jobs. There are no in-person forms that need to be signed anymore.

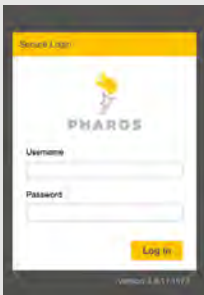
Releasing a Print Job

Your computer must either be connected to a PSU network or connected to the PSU VPN.

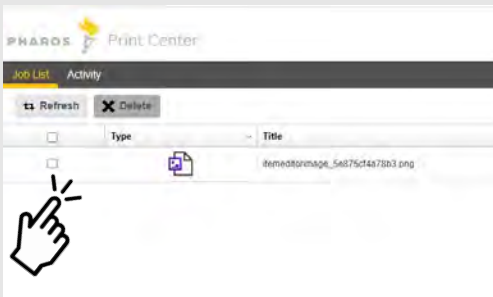
After connecting to the PSU VPN, open a new browser window and go here:
